Tim Cox has spent his professional career providing innovative and high quality long term care to the elderly. Before taking his position at the Armed Forces Retirement Home in September 2002, he held a top job at the nation's largest provider of senior living services. Mr. Cox was senior vice president, Northeast Region, for Sunrise Assisted Living, Inc., the nation's largest assisted living company based in McLean, Virginia. During his six years at Sunrise, he played an instrumental role in the company's dramatic growth from 23 to 200 homes. He coordinated regulatory and licensing matters; supervised the transformation of national support from a fragmented approach of seven independent departments into one effective field support team; served on three state committees to draft assisted living legislation and regulations; and acted as an advocate for the elderly residents he and his teams served.

Earlier in his career, Mr. Cox worked with two non-profit agencies; Holy Family Manor, a long-term care organization operated by the diocese of Allentown, and Philadelphia Presbytery Homes, Inc., a continuing care community in Philadelphia, Pa, where he was vice president of administration and general counsel. He helped the Holy Family Manor grow from one nursing home to 14 different facilities, including HUD housing for the elderly, assisted living homes, adult day care facilities and a certified Medicare/Medicaid home care agency.

He holds a BA from Bucknell University and a JD from Widener University and lives in Alexandria, Va.
